

# A personal vision of the last stages of ...the battle for Jerusalem

## ● The invasion of Jerusalem

Towards the end of the Armageddon period the world will think that the result of the battle for Jerusalem is a foregone conclusion and Jerusalem can now be claimed as an 'international city' for all faiths, thanks to the confederacy of nations gathered and the fact that they think they have finally ousted the Jews (Zech.14:1-2). The glory of this final overturning of Jerusalem will be **short lived**.

## ● Jesus confronts the invaders

This time period would be ideal for an Antichrist Pope, maybe some UN military top brass and an entourage of Protestant and Islamic leaders to enter Jerusalem and claim it as the 'city for all faiths'. **God often allows man to reach a stage where he thinks he has won.** At this time the image of Daniel's prophecy is complete right down to the toes, and ready to be knocked off its feet and broken in pieces, before it is later crushed (Dan.2:34-35).

Would there be a world televised transmission of this time? It makes sense for the most powerful man of the religious world who presides over a system that has persecuted God's remnant and shown disgraceful anti-Semitism down through the ages, to have a final face to face meeting with Jesus and His elect.

This could be the time for the fulfillment of the words:

- **“And when the lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming.”** 2 Thess.2:8

This could also coincide with the time of fulfillment of Jesus' prophecy He made to Caiaphas the High Priest who would have to be resurrected to witness Jesus' powerful coming (Matt.26:64). More than likely those who were responsible for Jesus' death and rejected His authority will also be resurrected to face the consequences.

- **“But bring here those enemies of mine, who do not want me to reign over them, and slay them before me.”** Luke 19:27

## ● The last great battle for Jerusalem

Once Jesus has indicated His rightful authority in Jerusalem ('the city of the Great King', Matt.5:35) the world will mistakenly identify Him as the Antichrist which will set the battle raging again.

- **“Why do the nations rage and the people plot a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against His Anointed.”** Psa.2:1-2

Jesus will once more retire to the Mount of Olives, only this time to instigate the greatest earthquake and release of natural forces and energy that the world has ever seen along with the destruction of the troops gathered.

- **“And in that day His feet will stand on the mount of Olives, which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the mount of Olives shall be split in two, from east to west...”** Zech.14:4

This split in the mount of Olives will be used as an escape route for any Jews who wish to seek shelter from the ensuing battle for Jerusalem (Zech.14:5).

It is possible that this giant quake will be felt worldwide as the entire rift valley down into Africa could move. This period could also bring about the destruction of the Aswan dam and send a huge wall of water and silt down into Egypt and bring about the fulfillment of another prophecy. This amount of silt could be that which creates the drying up of the Nile delta as foretold by Isaiah (Isa.11:15).

## ● Israel's national repentance

The prophet Zechariah tells us that two thirds of the Jews in the land will perish at this time, while the remaining survivors will be given extra strength to combat the invaders of Jerusalem. Following this, these Jews will then be brought to realise that it was not through their own strength they have achieved this but by God's strength invested in the Man they crucified 2000 years ago.

- **“...then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.”** Zech.12:10
